Ref: Bomb Threat at Oglesby School

At 11:37 am this date the Sheriff's Office received a 9-1-1 call from the Oglesby High School Principle Josh Carty. Mr. Carty reported that a staff member of the High School had just located a bomb threat written on one of the boy's bathroom walls. The writing indicated that the school will blow up. Also was a date of February 8, 2007.

Mr. Carty advised that they were in the process of evacuating all children and staff from the school.

Deputies from the Sheriff's Office along with Oglesby Fire Department and EMS personnel from Coryell Emergency Services responded to the scene

At 1:53 pm classes were allowed to resume. No device was located.

Sheriff's Office Investigators remained on the scene to continue the investigation. At the time of this release the investigation is still ongoing.

Additional Information

The evening of February 9, 2007 Investigators from the Coryell County Sheriff's Office took into custody a 15 year old male juvenile. He was charged with Making a false alarm or report, which is a State jail felony.

As of the time of this press release the juvenile is detained at a local juvenile facility.

The investigation is still ongoing and there will possibly be more arrest in this case.
